



REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

April 15, 2010 @ 6:00 P. M. at the Oran White Civic Center

Minutes

The City of Tool Regular City Council Meeting was called to order at 6:00pm. Present were Council Members Sonka, Wright, Reeder, Bush and Phillips. Quorum was established with Mayor Black Presiding.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Black.

Approve Minutes as presented: Regular City Council Meeting March 18th, 2010 Motion to approve minutes as presented was made by Council Member Phillips, second by Council Member Reeder. Motion passed 5-0.

Consent Agenda: Consideration and/or action to approve Monthly Activity Reports for March 2010:

(A) Municipal Court Report, (B) Police/Animal Control/Code Enforcement Report, (C) Financial and Expenditure Report, (D) Maintenance/Street Department Report, (E) Building / Street Department Report, (F) City of Tool Volunteer Fire Department Report. Motion to approve was made by Council Member Phillips second by Council Member Reeder. Motion passed 5-0.

ITEM 1: Wayne White, Chairman of “Our Kids First” Committee, request to speak on the Malakoff Independent School District’s Bond Election. Mr. White gave Campus specifics as well as tax increase information.

ITEM 2: Consideration and/or action to approve Cap City Dirt Work, LLC for the preliminary survey work on the Old Indian Trail Drainage Project. Motion to table was made by Council Member Phillips second by Council Member Bush. Motion to Table passed 5-0.

ITEM 3: Consideration and/or action to Order the Cancellation of the Special Election to fill an unexpired council term and after having been certified as unopposed do hereby declare Nelson Wright, incumbent, elected as Council Member to fill the unexpired term of one year term ending May 2011 and to take office during the regular canvassing period Motion to approve was made by Council Member Reeder, second Council Member Phillips. Motion passed 4-0; Council Member Wright abstained from vote.

ITEM 4: Consideration and/or action to approve the re-plat of Lakeway Estates Lots 59 & 60, Block 1, combined into Lot 59R, Block 1, as requested by property owner Steve Slaughter, 110 Ridge Oak Way. Motion to approve was made by Council Member Phillips, second Council Member Reeder. Motion passed 5-0.

- What is your primary goal if elected?
- What direction do you plan on taking the City?
- How do you plan on balancing the budget?
