



REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

May 20, 2010 @ 6:00 P. M. at the Oran White Civic Center

Minutes

The City of Tool Regular City Council Meeting was called to order at 6:01pm. Present were Council Members Williams, Phillips, Candage, Wright, and Reeder. Quorum was established with Mayor Black Presiding.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Black.

Approve Minutes as presented: Regular City Council Meeting, April 15, 2010, Special City Council Meeting, May 07, 2010, Special City Council Meeting – Election Canvass, May 13, 2010. Motion to approve minutes as presented was made by Council Member Reeder, second by Council Member Phillips. Motion passed 5-0.

Consent Agenda: Consideration and/or action to approve Monthly Activity Reports for April 2010:

(A) Municipal Court Report, (B) Police/Animal Control/Code Enforcement Report, (C) Financial and Expenditure Report, (D) Maintenance/Street Department Report, (E) Building / Street Department Report, (F) City of Tool Volunteer Fire Department Report. Motion to approve was made by Council Member Wright second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed 5-0.

ITEM 1: Mr. Dale Price, 819 Heather Wood Dr., request to come before Mayor and Council for removal of stop signs located at the intersections of: Heather Wood Drive @ Stevens Lane and at Will White Road @ Church Road. Motion to leave the stop signs as they are was made by Council Member Reeder Second by Council Member Phillips. Motion passed 5-0.

ITEM 2: Consideration and appointment of Mayor Pro Tem. Motion to nominate and appoint Councilman Phillips as Mayor Pro Tem was made by Council Member Reeder second by Council Member Candage. Councilman Phillips abstained from the vote. Motion passed 4-0.

ITEM 3: Consideration and/or action approving Resolutions 2010-01R-FNB, First National Bank; and 2010-02R-CSB, Citizens State Bank to provide corporate bank authorizations. Motion to approve was made by Council Member Williams second by Council Member Candage. Motion passed 5-0.

ITEM 4: Discussion on Road Program and update by Velvin & Weeks Engineering regarding maps and assessments that are underway. Tyler Hendricks from Velvin & Weeks gave a brief project update of the street surveys and aerial maps. Council was pleased with the progress and anticipates another update at next meeting.
