MINUTES

ITEM 1: The City of Tool, City Council meeting was called to order at 2:00 pm.

ITEM 2: Present were Council Member Pinnell, Council Member Whitehurst, Council Member Barr, Council Member Daniel, and Council Member Reeder. Quorum was established with Mayor Brickey presiding.


ITEM 3: Citizens Comments - none

ITEM 4: Consideration / Action on the replacement of the front ac unit at City Hall. Mayor Brickey stated that the air conditioning unit had already been replaced due to an emergency outage. The replacement cost for inside and outside units was \$4,650 and would come from emergency funds if need be. Motion to approve was made by Council member Daniel, second by Council Member Barr. Motion passed 5-0

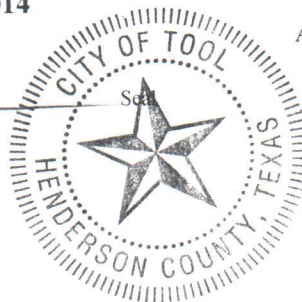
Item 5: General Discussion on FY 2014-2015 Budget. Mayor Brickey started discussions off by making an announcement. "I went to an outside private council, I paid for it myself and what you are doing, what I am supposed to be saying is what you are doing is totally illegal. As an elected Mayor, I am your Chief Administrator and we are going to run this City by the laws of the State of Texas. If you do not agree, we can, there are two things we can do. We can sit down with the City Attorney and my private Council or I can sue the City and the Courts can oversee the City". Council Member Reeder instructed the Mayor that she would need to sue the City. Mayor Brickey said that she did not like the thought of that. Council Member Daniel attempted to comment in regard to Mayor Brickey's announcement but was shut down by Mayor Brickey stating "That is my statement and that is it" accompanied by the continuous banging of her gavel. Council Member Daniel made several attempts to obtain the Mayors recognition for the floor so that he could comment. Mayor Brickey continued to bang her gavel stating "I said that's over it, over". At this time all members of Council with the exception of Council Member Pinnell began collecting their belongings and exiting the building. During their exit Mayor Brickey asked if there was a motion to adjourn and City Secretary informed her that the quorum of Council had been lost and that a motion could not be made.

Quorum of Council was lost at 2:05pm and the meeting was closed
