Minutes

The City of Tool City Council meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm. Present were Council Members Williams, Phillips, Candage, Wright and Reeder. Quorum was established with Mayor Black presiding.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Black

Approve Minutes as presented: Regular City Council Meeting, July 15 and Special City Council Meeting, August 12, 2010. Motion to approve was made by Council Member Phillips second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed 5-0.
