Minutes

The City of Tool Regular City Council Meeting was called to order at 6:00pm. Present were Council Members Bush, Phillips, Wright and Reeder. Council Member Sonka was absent. Quorum was established with Mayor Black Presiding.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Black.

Citizen Comments: No person signed up to speak

Approve Minutes as presented: Regular City Council Meeting October 15, 2009, Special City Council Meeting October 23, 2009. Motion to approve was made by Council Member Phillips second by Council Member Wright. Motion passed 4-0.

Consent Agenda: Consideration and/or action to approve Monthly Activity Reports for October 2009: (A) Municipal Court Report, (B) Police/Animal Control/Code Enforcement Report, (C) Financial and Expenditure Report, (D) Maintenance/Street Department Report, (E) Building / Street Department Report, (F) City of Tool Volunteer Fire Department Report. Motion to approve was made by Council Member Phillips second by Council Member Wright. Motion passed 4-0.

ITEM 1 Consideration and/or action to approve candidate selection to receive the City of Tool's 46 votes on the Official Ballot for Henderson County Appraisal District Board of Directors – Place 4. Motion to approve the allocation of the City of Tool's 46 votes for Sam (Mac) J. Mckinsey III on the Official Ballot for Henderson County Appraisal District Board of Directors – Place 4 was made by Council Member Phillips second by Council Member Wright. Motion passed 4-0.

ANNOUNCEMENTS and UPDATES: Mr. Buzzy Hale, Heatherwoods, expressed heart felt appreciation and sincere thanks to the Police and Fire departments for their response to an alarm triggered at his residence while he was away. Mayor Black spoke of the terrific response of our Fire Department, the over all outstanding job from our Police and Fire, and thanked everyone for their help at Halloween. Fire Chief Mike Howell thanked the Fire Department members for their dedication from response efforts to professionalism on scene. He then spoke of the success of the recent Haz-Mat class and prospects of an area Haz-Mat Team to include several local communities. Mayor Black complimented the Fire Department on their organization while on scene. Mayor Black then stated that there would be no more trash-off's held in November due to the lack of citizen response as only 1 of 3 dumpsters were filled on November 7th; future trash-off events would be held in the spring.
